### Project Initiative

- In the year 2015, Baba Balaknath Venerable Producers Group of Scheduled Caste families was formed by the employees of Technical Institute C.Bed, starting the initiative of livelihood project in Satagad village Block Jounpur.
- After the formation of the group, according to the demand of the members of the group, by selecting the goat rearing activity, cooperation was done to increase the goat rearing activity by giving the first contribution amount of Rs 3600 per member.
- If the members of the group belong to Scheduled Castes, an additional sum of Rs.1600 per member was given by the project as Venerable Producers Group, so that the members of the group can improve their economic condition.
- The members of Baba Balaknath Asahaya Utpadak Samah had negligible agricultural land and their livelihood depended only on daily wages and goat rearing. Prior to the project assistance, the group members had 2 to 3 goats per member and a total of 18 to 22 goats per year.
- To increase the business of goat rearing by the project, assistance of Rs 3600 was given to Dashajyula Livelihood Cooperative as the second installment, so

that the group can be self-dependent in future by taking the help of cooperative in goat rearing.
